Report dated 8.10.2018 of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Dasuya has been received after recording statements of accused Ajay Mehta alias Ajay Kumar as well as complainant Pawandeep Kaur and the learned court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise is an outcome of voluntariness, free will and without any coercion or undue pressure. In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and in view of the fact that compromise will go a long way in resolving the personal dispute and to bring about personal harmony and would be for the betterment of

future lives of the parties and more-so the offences for which the accused have been booked are not of very serious nature and in view of the law laid down in **Gian Singh vs State of Punjab and another, 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs State of Punjab and another, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052** and in view of which the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 150 dated 6.10.2016, under Sections 354, 506 IPC, Section 67 of I.T. Act, registered at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur and all consequences arising thereof are quashed, qua the present petitioner.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
