The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.82, dated 11.4.2019, registered under Sections 381/34 of the IPC, at Police Station City Kapurthala.

Counsel for the petitioner, counsel for the complainant as well as learned DAG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Harparshad, have stated that the matter has been settled.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, this petition is allowed and it is directed that in the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his

satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in
Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if
any, also stand disposed of.
