This petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.42 dated 10.03.2018, registered
under Sections 323/506/307/34 IPC, Police Station Bichhore, District Nuh.

Heard learned counsel on either side.

The petitioner has been specifically named in the FIR. The
victim has suffered injuries at his hands who had allegedly tried to
strangulate him. Learned counsel for the complainant states that the victim
is still under treatment.

Keeping in view the nature of offence and the fact that the
petitioner played an active role in the occurrence, no ground is made out in
extending the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present fails and it stands dismissed.
