This order shall dispose of above mentioned four contempt petitions.

Separate replies in all four contempt petitions by way of affidavits of Sh. Charanjit Singh, P.F.S. Divisional Forest Officer, Ludhiana, filed in Court, are taken on record. A copy of the same are handed over to learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that liberty be granted to challenge order dated 08.07.2019. He further raises the grievance that the claim with regard to the pension of the petitioners has not been decided.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Sh. Charanjit Singh, Divisional Forest Officer, Ludhiana submits that the claim of the petitioner(s) for pension is not accepted as it is governed by new policy. He seeks time to pass a reasoned order after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioners.

In view of the above, the contempt petitions are disposed of. However, the respondents shall pass an order with regard to the claim of the pension within six weeks from today.

In order to avoid unnecessary delay, the petitioners are directed to remain present in the office of respondent No. 2 on 03.10.2019

at 11.00 AM.

It is clarified, in case, there is any grievance with regard to the order dated 08.07.2019, passed now, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.
