This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 31.10.2018 passed in CWP No.25049 of 2015.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider the validity of the said certificate and if it is found valid document then grant necessary benefit against the same at the time of determining the seniority and promotion of the petitioners. The necessary exercise be done within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order.

However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter."

An order dated 27.8.2019 has been produced in Court today, copy handed over to counsel for the petitioners.

In the said order, the claim of the petitioners for promotion has been rejected. However, it has been ordered that in exercise of review of

promotion which is already under way, the petitioners shall be considered.

Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law to challenge the order passed.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
