The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.182, dated 31.10.2018, registered under Sections 306, 34 of the IPC, at Police Station Bass, District Hisar.

As per allegations, the deceased committed suicide because the petitioner had not returned his money.

Learned AAG Haryana, on instructions from SI Jagdish Ram, has accepted this factual assertion.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, this petition is allowed and it is directed that in the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory

bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
