FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 12.10.2018 of learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Division)-cum-Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Kosli, has been received whereby after recording statements of injured Daya Ram, Karan Singh, Karampal and Sudrshana Devi and the accused persons, namely Ved Parkash, Devender Kumar, Hemant Kumar and Prem Lata, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Learned counsel for the accused/petitioners has made statement that as per instructions received, the parties had given final effect to their agreement settlement/compromise (Annexure P2) and that

nothing is due towards anyone on account of this settlement and that the final effect be given to this petition.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the fact that the parties on both sides are neighbours and the offenses for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in **‘Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another’ 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543** and **‘Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another’ 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.49 dated 23.03.2017 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 354A, 452, 506, 354D, 325, 34 IPC pertaining to Police Station Kosli, District Rewari and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands disposed off in those terms.
