Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that vide Award dated 17.2.2016, three land references i.e., *land reference No. 191 dated 6.4.1994*, titled as *Harcharan Singh etc., vs. State of Punjab and others*, *land reference No. 14 dated 6.4.1994* titled as *Pritam Singh vs. Punjab State and others* and *land reference No. 181 dated 6.4.1994* titled as *Harcharan Singh and others vs. Punjab State and others* were decided and compensation was enhanced to Rs. 5,32,800/- per acre along with statutory benefits as envisaged in Sections 23(1-A), 23 (2) and 28 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1984.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that petitioners have filed an application under Section 152 of the Code of Civil Procedure for amendment of the said Award by mentioning the khasra numbers in the relief clause for the land belonging to Raghbir Singh-applicant in land

reference number 181 dated 6.4.1994, which has been dismissed.

I am of the view that since learned Additional District Judge, Gurdaspur decided all the three references, therefore, there is no need to mention the specific khasra numbers of the land references in the relief clause. Once the land references are decided, these are deemed to be pertained to khasra numbers mentioned in the said land references.

In view of above, present petition is disposed of with the observation that khasra numbers are not required to be mentioned in the relief clause and deemed to pertain to the land mentioned in the three land references which were decided by the Award dated 17.2.2016. Hence, there is no need for correction of the Award.
