The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0149 dated 24.8.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 354-A, 452, 506, 342, 328, 34 of Indian Penal Code and 67 of Information Technology Act, at Police Station Jakhal, District Fatehabad.

Heard.

The petitioner along with one Kuldeep alias Deepa had enticed the prosecutrix to go Patran in a pick-up van where she was served with intoxicant substance administered in a tea and when became unconscious, her clothes were removed and her nude photographs were clicked and those were put on the internet. The petitioner had stored the nude photographs in his mobile. That mobile phone has been produced before the investigating

agency. It seems that he has concealed the actual mobile.

Keeping in view the seriousness of the offence and the allegations levelled against the petitioner, this Court is of the view that the petitioner is not entitled to the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Dismissed.
