The claim in the present writ petition is that the petitioner who was working as Safai Sewak with the respondent Corporation and retired on 31.12.2018 and all his pensionary benefits have been withheld except the payment of ₹4,00,000/-, which was given to him when he retired and thereafter on 18.03.2019.

Counsel for the petitioner states that there is no impediment for the release of the said benefits as no departmental inquiry or any other proceeding is pending against the petitioner, which would entitle the respondents to withhold the benefits.

Counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been sought in the present writ petition, petitioner has sent a representation dated 20.03.2019 (Annexure P-2) to the respondents,

which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, the respondents are directed to decide the representation dated 20.03.2019 (Annexure P-2) by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case after the decision, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefit, the same shall also be released to him within a period of next three months.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
