Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.140 dated 31.08.2018 under Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station City Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is ready to hand over a demand draft of Rs.1.00 lac favouring complainant Sukhdev Singh, without prejudice to right of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Binder Singh, has not disputed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and submits that he has handed over the ATM card.

Learned counsel for the complainant has however submitted that the petitioner has purchased the motorcycle by using the said ATM card.

Without commenting anything further on merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to confirm the order dated 26.09.2018 passed by this Court, vide which interim bail was granted to the petitioner and the same is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

It is directed that the petitioner will hand over a demand draft of Rs.1.00 lac to the complainant on or before 25.02.2019, without prejudice to his rights.

It is clarified that in case the petitioner failed to hand over the aforesaid demand draft to the complainant, it will be open for the complainant to apply for cancellation of bail.
