Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.45 dated 25.02.2014 under Sections 452, 506, 427, 148 & 149 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise dated 30.07.2014 (Annexure P-2)

In compliance to the order dated 29.11.2018, report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Barnala has been received that the parties have been entered into compromise with the intervention of respectables without any pressure or coercion.

In view of the matter, continuation of proceedings before the trial Court is useless exercise. Accordingly, FIR No.45 dated 25.02.2014 under Sections 452, 506, 427, 148 & 149 of Indian Penal Code, registered at

Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential proceedings stands quashed qua the petitioners.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
