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**GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)**

The petitioners have approached this Court seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.4 and 5 to protect their life and liberty and to provide them adequate security as they apprehend threat to the same at the hands of the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that husband of petitioner No.1 namely Iqbal Singh had purchased a big chunk of land in Rajasthan as well as in Village Shahbhini and other villages in Punjab. However, there was a dispute amongst the co-sharers of the said land with the husband of petitioner No.1 and said co-sharers used to threaten the petitioners being wife and son of Iqbal Singh as well as Iqbal Singh and on account of which the petitioners moved to Village Shahbhini in Fazilka and started residing with their cousin. It is alleged that the private respondents, however, followed them and fired at their jeep on account of which FIR No.25, dated 28.3.2017 was registered at Police Station Bahawala, District Fazilka for offences under Sections 307, 506, 148, 149 IPC and 25 of Arms

Act. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the private respondents are desperate type of persons having links with gangsters and that the petitioners nurse grave apprehensions regarding their security.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Jagraon (Rural), Ludhiana, District Ludhiana (respondent No.4) to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law. In case it is found that there is any imminent threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners, then it be ensured that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation Annexure P-2 be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jagraon (Rural), Ludhiana, District Ludhiana (respondent No.4) so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
