Challenge is to the order passed by Special Judge, Moga disposing of the application for supplying hard copies of call details.

It may be noted that petitioner is an accused in FIR No.53 dated 15.4.2017 registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act at Police Station City South Moga.

Petitioner initially filed an application for preserving the call details and tower locations of various telephone numbers of Sub Inspectors, Head Constable, Constables and PHG. The Court allowed that application on 1.2.2018.

As noticed above, now the application has been filed for providing the hard copies of the call details and tower locations. All the telephone numbers are of private cellular operators which are not party to the present proceedings. Still further once the call details have been

preserved, the accused would be at liberty to summon the relevant record

from the concerned service provider in his evidence or for the purpose of cross-examination. Hence, no ground to interfere with the order passed is made out.

Dismissed.
