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**Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral)**

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.288 dated 20.08.2018 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 323, 324, 341, 326, 506, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.5, Ludhiana, Punjab on the basis of compromise dated 05.09.2018 (Annexure P-2) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

In compliance of the order dated 21.09.2018, passed by this Court, report of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana has been received and reported that statement of both the parties have been recorded. It has been reported that parties have entered into compromise and that the same is with their free will and without any pressure.

In view of the fact that the parties have entered into compromise, the case is unlikely to succeed and continuation of proceedings before the trial Court will be useless exercise. As such, FIR No.288 dated 20.08.2018 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 323, 324, 341, 326, 506, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.5, Ludhiana along with subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, stands quashed qua the petitioners.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
