The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.95 dated 10.04.2015, under Sections 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short), registered at Police Station Division No.5, Civil Lines, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and has been falsely implicated as her husband is alleged to be involved in the offence. She is not involved in any other case and has a minor child to look after.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 22.02.2018, had released the petitioner on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Tarlochan, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 22.02.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
