Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 4 to look into his representation dated 09.10.2017 (Annexure P-1), which has not been decided by them till date.

On 21.09.2018, this Court had passed the following order:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite order dated 22.12.2017 passed in CRM-M-49417-2017, no steps have been taken by the police to examine the representation of the petitioner dated 09.10.2017.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only for 11.12.2018”

In response to above order, a reply by way of affidavit of Ramandeep Singh Bhullar, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (South), Ludhiana dated 11.12.2018 was filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4. In the reply, it has been highlighted that pursuant to the order passed by this Court on 22.11.2017 in CRM-M-49417-2017, the representation was looked

into in detail by way of an inquiry and the allegations were found to be false.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous.
