Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.701 dated 21.08.2017 under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Suraj Kund, District Faridabad.

Vide order dated 12.12.2017, parties were directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre on 12.12.2017 itself.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties had appeared before the Mediation Centre and it has been reported by the Mediator that the Settlement/Agreement dated 21.02.2019 has been entered between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that now the parties

have compromised the matter and are residing together as husband and wife.

This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the complainant.

Learned State Counsel submits that since the matter has been compromised between the parties, police has prepared the untraced report on 10.05.2019.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the fact that the matter has been resolved between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 01.11.2017 is made absolute.
