Applicant Kiranpreet Kaur wife of Amarjit Singh, the respondent, by way of moving the present application, seeks transfer of civil suit having title Amarjit Singh Vs. Kiranpreet Kaur, pending in the Court of Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.) Hoshiarpur to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana, on the ground that due to criminal background of the plaintiff, she apprehends danger to her life, when she goes to Hoshiarpur to attend the dates of hearing and she has informed the local police in that regard. Furthermore, her father in-law is a cancer patient, who requires constant care and looking after.

I have heard learned counsel for the applicant besides going through the record and I find that the nature of the case, sought to be got transferred, is a civil suit where personal appearance of the parties on each and every date of hearing is not required and they can appear through their counsel. As regards threat perception of the

applicant, she has already reported the matter to the police, which may take necessary action in the matter in accordance with law and thirdly for the reason that father in-law of the applicant suffering from ailments, the applicant can look after him. However, no justifiable reason is there to transfer the civil suit as requested for in the application. The application being without merit stands dismissed.
