This is an application under Section 5 read with Section 14 of the Limitation Act for condonation of 66 days delay in filing the present review petition. The application is supported by an affidavit.

For the reasons stated in the application, delay of 66 days in filing the present review petition, is condoned.

RA-CW-200-2019

Present application has been filed for recalling the order dated 16.01.2019 by which the present writ petition was dismissed as withdrawn.

Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner states that during the hearing, which took place on 16.01.2019, certain averments which were made in paragraph 10 and 11 of the petition, could not be argued and according to the same, the petitioner has a prima facie case in his favour in respect of the relief being sought and therefore, counsel for the review-petitioner prays that he be allowed to withdraw his statement of withdrawing the writ petition so that the petition can be argued and decided on merits.

Keeping in view the averments made in the review application, counsel for the petitioner is allowed to withdraw his

statement of withdrawing the petition so as to enable the counsel to argue the writ petition in view of the averments made in paragraph 10 and 11 of the petition.

Keeping in view the fact mentioned above, counsel for the petitioner is allowed to withdraw his statement of withdrawing the petition and order dated 16.01.2019 is recalled.

CM stand allowed.
