AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners have no objection with regard to the installing of underground water pipes but he asserts that the said orders be duly complied with in letter and spirit. The sanction which has been granted for laying down the underground water pipes should be as per the sanction so accorded and violation thereof should not be permitted. Petitioners have submitted representations to the Divisional Canal Officer, dated 02.04.2019 (Annexure P-4) and to the Superintending Canal Officer, Ferozepur Canal Circle, Ferozepur, on 26.04.2019 (Annexure P-5), respondents No.3 and 2 respectively.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to interfere as it is for the authorities to see as to whether their orders have been complied with in letter and spirit or not and this Court is sanguine that

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in case there is any violation of the orders passed by them, appropriate action will be taken against the persons concerned.

The writ petition stands disposed of with above observations.
