ANIL KSHETARPAL, J.

The present petition has been filed with the following substantive prayers:-

“It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that Crl. Misc. Petition may kindly be allowed and directions be issued to the respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to provide adequate security for protection of life and liberty of petitioner from the hands of respondent no.4 as respondent no.4 continuously threatening the petitioner that he will be killed if petitioner will be taking any action against the respondent No.4 and her relatives.

It is further prayed for issuance of directions to the official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of petitioner and to ensure the security of life and liberty of the petitioner which is at the imminent danger at the hands of respondent No.4 and her relatives.”

Pursuant to notice, reply by way of affidavit has been filed, wherein, it has been submitted that marriage between the petitioner and respondent No.4 was solemnised and out of their wedlock, two children namely Sukhdeep Kaur and Kulwinder Singh were born. Then there was some matrimonial discord due to which parties started living separately. It

has further been pointed out that the petitioner has never contacted the police officials regarding his grievances as alleged in the petition. It was further claimed that the application attached with the petition has never been received. The present petition is pending for the last four years. Efforts to mediate between both the parties have failed.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is disposed of by giving opportunity to the petitioner to file representation, if he still has any grievance.
