On 01.05.2019, following order was passed:-

“The petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 7 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents no.4 to 7. They have placed on record photographs Annexures P-5 evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 27.04.2019, Annexure P-6 to the Superintendent of Police, Nuh, District Nuh, respondent no.2.

Notice of motion.

Sh. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, accept notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3 and prays for time to file a status report. A copy of the petition be supplied to the

State counsel during the course of the day.

Mr. Mohammad Arshad, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.4 to 7.

In the meantime, respondent no.2 would examine the threat perceptions and if found necessary, interim protection would be provided to them. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.

Adjourned to 09.05.2019.”

Status report by way of affidavit of Ashok Kumar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, has been filed. He has also attached copies of statements of respondent Nos.4 to 7 who have stated that they shall not interfere in the life of the petitioners.

Counsel for the petitioners is also not present.

Keeping in view the aforesaid statements, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. However, the order passed by this Court shall not be construed as declaration on the validity of the marriage.
