The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.2 and 3 for protection of their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7, as they have married against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned State counsel has filed statements of the petitioners and Rekha-mother of petitioner No.1 in the Court and the same are taken on record. Copy thereof have been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioners. In the statements, it is mentioned that petitioners do not face any threat and private respondents have no objection to the marriage of the

petitioners. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioners.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition, as the alleged threat has vanished.

The prayer is accepted.

The petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn.
