Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.189 dated 06.09.2018 registered under Sections 34/354/354-A(1)(ii), 354-A(I)(iv)/354-D of IPC and Section 3(1)(w)(i) of SC & ST Act, 1989 at Women Police Station, Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 24.09.2018 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the complainant-respondent No.2 has argued that the allegation against the petitioner are serious.

However, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI

the investigation and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 24.09.2018 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
