AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court challenging the order dated 18.04.2018 (Annexure P-12) passed by the Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Collector, Ferozepur, order dated 16.10.2017 (Annexure P-9) and the order dated 10.05.2018 (Annexure P-15) passed by the Tehsildar-cum-Sub Registrar, Ferozepur.

2. It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that the impugned orders cannot sustain as the same are contrary to the authorities which are conferred on them under the statute. He contends that the revenue authorities do not have the jurisdiction to review its own order as the mutation has been rightly sanctioned in the name of the petitioner, which has been reviewed by passing of the impugned order. He, however, conceded that the petitioner has filed an appeal against the orders which have been passed by the authorities and impugned in the present writ petition.

3. In the light of the above fact that the petitioner has already availed of the remedy under the statute and the appeal is pending before the competent authority, the prayer as made in the present writ petition cannot be entertained and, therefore, the writ petition stands dismissed.
