G.S. SANDHAWALIA, J. (Oral) :

The petitioner seeks decision on his representation/legal notice dated 25.1.2019 (Annexure P-4) regarding re-fixation of revised pension in the 7th Central Pay Commission (CPC) w.e.f. 1.1.2016.

Counsel submits that the benefit of the revised calculation sheet as per the 7th Central Pay Commission w.e.f. 1.1.2016 has not been disbursed to the petitioner though it has been sent to the Accounts Branch for revision. Reference is made to letter dated 31.8.2018 (Annexure P-3) regarding this aspect. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even a legal notice dated 25.1.2019 (Annexure P-4) has been served upon the respondents regarding this aspect.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Karminder Singh, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3. Copy supplied.

Keeping in view the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this Court is of the opinion that reply would further delay the matter. Accordingly, direction is issued to respondent No.2 to take a

decision on letter dated 31.8.2018 (Annexure P-3) and on the legal notice dated 25.1.2019 (Annexure P-4), within a period of 2 months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, the amount is due, the same be disbursed expeditiously within a period of one month thereafter. In case of any legal impediment reasoned order be passed, and the same be communicated to the petitioner as to why the benefits cannot be granted.

The petition stands disposed of.
