Heard.

It is stated that the petitioner has undergone Gallbladder surgery to remove the stone on 25.4.2019.

The operation was done through Laparoscopy. Therefore, long rest is not required in such cases.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. S.S. Deol, DAG, Punjab, present in Court, accepts notice.

It comes out that parole granted to the petitioner has already expired on 26.4.2019. Petitioner earlier approached this Court by filing *CWP-10771-2019* titled as *Sher Singh vs. State of Punjab and others*, (Annexure P-3), which was disposed of vide order dated 25.4.2019 with a direction to approach Divisional Commissioner, Patiala for extension of parole.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the Divisional Commissioner, Patiala has refused to grant extension.

I am of the view that as per the doctor certificate, only rest is required which can be very well availed in jail itself by giving appropriate directions.

As such, prayer for further extension of the parole is declined. Petitioner is directed to surrender before the jail authorities. However, the jail authorities shall ensure that he is given adequate post operation care in jail and the petitioner be kept in jail hospital for some time, so he may fully recover from the operation.

Petition stands dismissed.
