Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.301 dated 28.12.2018 under Sections 186, 147, 148, 149, 332, 353, 307, 506, 341, 427, 225, 511 IPC, registered at Police Station Loharu, District Bhiwani.

As per allegations in the FIR, on 27.12.2018, the police party had gone to village of the petitioner to arrest his son namely Pardeep Kumar. After the police party arrested him, the petitioner along with 20-25 other armed assailants, with intention to kill the govt. officials, who had gone to perform their legal duty, caused injuries to them.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the injuries attributed to the petitioner are simple in nature and his co-accused have already been granted the concession of regular bail and three other co-accused, who are the ladies, have also been granted the concession of anticipatory bail.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, considering the serious allegations against the petitioner that he has not only obstructed the police officials in discharge of their duty, but have also caused injuries to them, while attacking the police party and forcibly tried to rescue the arrested person i.e. his son namely Pardeep Kumar, no ground to grant anticipatory bail to him is made out.
