Learned counsel for respondent No.1 contended that the present petition has been rendered infructuous as petitioners No.1 and 3 have been acquitted after trial and copy of the judgment dated 21.02.2018 has been placed on the file.

In view of the above, the present petition rendered infructuous qua petitioners No.1 and 3. As regard, petitioner No.2, the present petition dismissed. However, petitioner No.2, who had already been declared proclaimed offender, in at liberty to surrender before the learned trial Court, at the first instance for rederessal of his grievance within a period of two weeks from today and in case any application for releasing him on bail filed before learned trial Judge, the same shall be decided within a period of one week, thereafter.
