The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.2 to 4 to grant him protection for cultivating his crops as they have grave danger at the hands of private respondents No.5 to 10, who is allegedly prohibited from cultivating/harvesting his crops.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the representation dated 17.01.2019 (Annexure P-2) already stands given on 17.01.2019. A perusal of the same reveals that the dispute is of civil nature and the relief claimed is equivalent to injunction.

Since there is an alternative remedy available under the law, therefore, no ground is made out for invoking the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Petition stands dismissed.
