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RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing of FIR No.0090 dated 15.03.2016 registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467 & 471 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC'), at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 19.09.2018 (Annexure P-2).

Perusal of the file shows that the case was sent to the trial court thrice; for recording of statements qua genuineness of the compromise. However, once the report had come that the parties did not appear to get their statements recorded, and twice the report has come that both the respondents-complainants have not appeared to make the statement qua compromise relied upon by the petitioners.

In view of the above, the compromise between the parties does not appear to be genuine. Therefore, there is no ground for proceeding further with the present petition.

Hence the present petition is dismissed.

However, this order would not preclude the petitioners from filing fresh petition, in case there is any compromise between the parties.
