Learned State counsel submits that during pendency of writ petition, the order impugned herein dated 12.04.2019(Annexure P-4) has been withdrawn and the petitioner has been accorded the benefit of correct date of birth i.e. 15.04.1967. She has handed over vernacular of order dated 08.05.2019, which is taken on record. However, the learned counsel for petitioner submits that after reinstatement into service, the petitioner has not been paid salary for 23 days, apart from non grant of benefit of continuity in service.

In view of the aforesaid, the writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. However, the respondents are directed to pass appropriate orders with regard to the grievance of the petitioner in respect of non-payment of salary and continuity of service, within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
