This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.49 dated 12.04.2019 registered under Sections 406/420/465/467/468/471/120-B IPC at Police Station Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

After arguing for some time and realizing that this Court is not inclined to grant any relief to the petitioner, counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw this petition and states that the petitioner would surrender and move an application for regular bail before the court below and a direction be issued to the court to decide his bail application expeditiously. I find this to be a fair request.

Learned Deputy Advocate General states that she has no objection to this course of action.

In the circumstances, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn. It is directed that in case the petitioner surrenders before the court on or before 20.05.2019 and move an application for regular bail, it shall be decided expeditiously but in any case by 22.05.2019.

Since the main case has been dismissed as withdrawn, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
