The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.64 dated 27.02.2018 registered under Sections 328, 451, 149 IPC at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar.

The operative part of the order dated 06.05.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioner relies upon the order dated 23.01.2019 passed by this Court in CRM-M No.40160 of 2018 to submit that the interim anticipatory bail of the co-accused of the petitioner has already been confirmed.

Notice of motion for 22.05.2019. ”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 06.05.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Gurdish Rana, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner

has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 06.05.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
