AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 30.07.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.21091 of 2017.

The relevant portion of the order is reproduced below:-

“Without going into the merits of the case and commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.2 to 4 to consider and decide the application/representation dated 16.02.2016 (Annexure P-9) in accordance with the procedure as prescribed under the statute and the instructions within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.”

Pursuant to order dated 26.08.2019, Mr. Tikaram Gautam, Tehsildar, Shahabad Markanda, District Kurukshetra is present in the Court. He tenders his unconditional apology for not sending instructions to the State counsel within time.

Reply has been filed today in the Court, same is taken on record. Copy of reply is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner. It is pleaded that needful, as per directions of this Court could not be done as petitioner failed to produce Death Certificate and Succession Certificate. There is nothing on record to show that petitioner was asked for the said documents.

The contempt petition is disposed of with the direction that in case the petitioner submits Death Certificate and Succession Certificate, the respondents shall do the needful in accordance with law within six weeks thereafter, provided that all other conditions are fulfilled.

The rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
