ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.1199 dated 18.10.2017 under Sections 307, 420, 468, 472, 120-B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Central Faridabad, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was found innocent in the course of investigation and has been summoned to face trial on an application preferred under Section 319 of the Code of Criminal Procedure. However, the allegations in the FIR against the petitioner are that he fired pistol which hit on the left leg of the complainant.

This Court, by the order dated 17.05.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the trial Court and he was to be released on ad-interim bail on his furnishing bonds to its satisfaction.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner had appeared before the trial Court in terms of the order dated 17.05.2019 of this Court and he had been granted interim bail by the trial Court on 23.05.2019. He has furnished the copy of the order of the trial Court dated 23.05.2019 which is taken on record.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having appeared before the trial Court, the order dated 17.05.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall appear before the trial Court as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
