This order shall dispose off first anticipatory bail
application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. moved in FIR No.
0025 dated 07.02.2019 under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC
Police Station Sadar Kharar, District S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali).

The precise allegations against petitioner-Gurjant

Singh has been levelled by complainant/wife Jaswinder Kaur alleging that marriage between the two was solemnized on 03.12.2017, wherein, sufficient dowry articles were given. It is alleged that in spite of the same, the accused and his family were unhappy with the same on account of greed of more dowry including cash. She further alleged that physical and mental cruelty being heaped upon the complainant and as a consequence of which the present FIR has been lodged.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the couple has reconciled and is residing together happily together and that all the dowry articles have been returned.

Mr. Harbir Sandhu, AAG, Punjab learned State counsel assisted by ASI Gurdev Singh has fairly conceded and stated at bar that all the articles of *Istridhan* have been received by the complainant and that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner and he does not oppose the

grant of bail.

In the light of what has been stated by the two sides before this Court, it is ordered that in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on *interim* bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall, however, join the investigation as and when called for to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Thereafter, will be released on regular bail upon presentation of challan.
