Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of order dated 14.08.2015 (Annexure P-2) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana in FIR No.8 dated 14.01.2014 registered under Sections 363, 366-A, 120-B of IPC at Police Station Division No.7, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) whereby the petitioner was declared as proclaimed person.

This Court, vide order dated 06.11.2017, had directed the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within a week and on his doing so, he was directed to be released on interim bail by the trial Court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Arvinder Singh, states that in the aforesaid FIR, the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and as on date, the victim Kanchan is staying with the petitioner as his wife and out of their wedlock, two children have been born.

In view of above, the present petition is hereby rendered infructuous and disposed of as such.

However, in case the petitioner feels that the information so furnished is contrary to record, he is at liberty to revive the present petition.
