Notice of motion.

Mr.Ramdeep Partap Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes that the petitioner would not remain absent in the pending proceedings before the learned trial court. He also submits that the petitioner was regularly appearing before the learned trial court except two dates of hearing.

It has been pointed out that petitioner is an accused in a case under Section 379 of the Indian Penal Code. Challan was presented by the police in the year 2017 but trial has not made any progress. Petitioner was released on regular bail. Now, non-bailable warrants have been issued on account of the fact that the petitioner did not appear before the trial court on 11.01.2019.

Keeping in view the undertaking given, petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned trial court on 30.05.2019 and will move an application for being released on bail which shall be allowed by the learned

trial court on his furnishing fresh bail bonds with heavy surety to its satisfaction.

It is clarified that this order has been passed only on the undertaking given by the learned counsel for the petitioner and in future if petitioner commits any default, he shall not be entitled for any concession of bail.

Disposed of, accordingly.
