Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.6 dated 31.01.2015 registered under Sections 279, 427 and 304-A of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station, Jalandhar Cantt., District Jalandhar.

It has been asserted in the petition that the petitioner was granted concession of regular bail but he absented himself from the court proceedings since 10.08.2017. Even prior to that his presence was being got exempted by the court.

Thereafter, he filed an application for grant of anticipatory bail which was rejected vide order dated 02.08.2018. The petitioner was declared proclaimed offender vide order 07.08.2018. Now the present petition has been filed after a period of eight months.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, there is no ground to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. However, if the petitioner surrenders before the trial court within 10 days and moves an application for being released on regular bail, the said application shall be considered by the trial court within three days.

Disposed of, accordingly.
