Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.18 dated 13.03.2019 under Sections 323, 324, 326, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Qadian, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

While granting interim bail to the petitioners, following order was passed by this Court on 16.05.2019: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, the injuries attributed to the petitioners are only on the non-vital part and two accused persons, namely Gursharan Singh and Amandeep Singh @ Amani already stand arrested, against whom there are allegations of causing injuries invoking Section 326 IPC.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Rajbir Singh, submits that petitioners be directed to join investigation as the recovery is still to be effected....”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kulwinder Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioners are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 16.05.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
