The claim of the petitioner is against respondent No. 3, which is a private aided college and for the claim of an employee against the management of a private aided college, appropriate forum is Educational Tribunal at the first instance. As per Clause 7-A(12) of the Punjab Affiliated Colleges (Security of Service of Employees) Act, 1974 as amended from time to time, all the disputes between the Managing Committee and the employees are to be adjudicated by/before the Educational Tribunal. The relevant clause is as under:-

“(12) The Educational Tribunal shall have jurisdiction to hear all cases of disputes between the 'Managing Committee' and the 'employees' as defined in this Act, and the Punjab Privately Managed Recognized Schools Employees (Security of Service) Act, 1979.”

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner requests that he be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach the Educational Tribunal, Punjab for the redressal of his grievance.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
