Petitioner, who happens to be a practicing Advocate of this Court, alleges mishandling and harassment at the hands of Chandigarh Traffic Police officials in an incident that allegedly took place on 28.9.2018. Counsel would submit that while the petitioner was proceeding along with his wife and other family members from Naya Gaon to Sector 15, Chandigarh in a car bearing registration no. PB-65-AD-4290, he was stopped by the two police officials near the Punjab Engineering College and for no reason was physically assaulted and even his personal documents as also the car papers were snatched. It is further contended that even a challan slip was not issued to him.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner at length and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach the S.S.P (Traffic), U.T., Chandigarh as regards his grievance. In the eventuality of any complaint/representation being filed, respondent no.3 would be obligated to examine the same and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and warranted in accordance with law.
