The present petition has been filed seeking issuance of a direction to respondent No.3 to submit the final report in FIR No.0093 dated 29.05.2018 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 325/323/506 of the Indian Penal Code (later on added Section 307 IPC) registered at Police Station Commissionerate, Police Station Division-3, Ludhiana.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Harshpreet Kaur has submitted that since respondent No.4 who is the only accused nominated in the FIR could not be arrested, the Investigating Officer has obtained non-bailable warrants from the Illaqa Magistrate on 23.01.2019 and further proceedings will be initiated after the arrest of respondent No.4.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Investigating Officer that as and when the accused/respondent No.4 is

arrested, the challan will be presented within a period of three months thereafter.
