Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.80 dated 08.09.2018 under Sections 406, 498-A, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Vairoke, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 27.09.2018, petitioner has joined the investigation. He further states that the parties were directed to appear before the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court on 25.10.2018.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, the parties have joined the mediation proceedings and the matter has been compromised between them.

A report has been received from the Mediation Centre along with

compromise/settlement dated 20.12.2018 entered into between the parties.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Surinder Kumar, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the settlement so arrived at between the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 27.09.2018 is made absolute.

The parties shall adhere to the terms & conditions of the settlement so arrived at between them.
