By this common order, CRM-M-20060-2019 and CRM-M-24612-2019 shall stand disposed of.

In both the petitions, prayer is for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.39 dated 14.03.2019 registered under Sections 379-B, 411, 34 of IPC, at Police Station Sadar Nabha, District

Patiala.

Petitioners are young boys aged about 20 and 19 years. They are in custody since 15.03.2019. As per FIR, they snatched JIO mobile phone and ₹2810/- from the first informant/victim. Investigating Officer namely ASI Gurcharan Singh, who is present in the Court has informed the Court that the investigations are complete and challan has been presented and both of them are not involved in any other case.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, petitioners are directed to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, both the petitions are allowed.
