This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.643 dated 12.12.2018 registered under Sections 406/420/120-B IPC at Police Station Sector 10-A, Gurugram.

Counsel for the petitioners on instructions states that the petitioners are ready to settle this dispute with the complainant and after some arguments it is decided that the petitioners shall pay an amount of Rs.38.00 lakhs to the complainant within a period of 5 months and this would be in full and final settlement of the entire claim of the complainant and thereafter the complainant will re-transfer the property back to the petitioners and the petitioners shall bear the registration charges. It has also

compromise and the petitioners would be entitled to move a petition for quashing the FIR on the basis of today's compromise and the further attendance of the complainant would not be required. The payment shall be made in five installments upto 31.10.2019. The first installment will be of Rs.10.00 lacs which will be payable on the 01.07.2019 and the remaining installments would be of Rs.7.00 lakhs each and payable on the 1st of each month.

In view of this settlement, I deem it appropriate to grant interim bail to the petitioners. Meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 10.06.2019 (from 09.00 AM to 05.00 PM) or on any other day on which the Investigating Officer requires their presence, and in the event of their arrest, the petitioners shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

When the full payment is made on or before 31.10.2019 the interim bail shall be confirmed and, in case of default the same would be liable to be vacated.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
