ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

 The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 096 dated 30.12.2018, under Sections 420/467/468/471 IPC registered at Police Station Ranjit Avenue, District Amritsar.

 Learned counsel for the petitioner contends the allegations in the FIR against the petitioner are that he was present when the complainant had given money to the co-accused Sukhdeep Singh Sandhu. The petitioner was only an employee of Sukhdeep Singh Sandhu and there is no allegation that any money has been paid to the petitioner either by cash or cheque. The petitioner is not involved in any other case and is in custody for over 4 months.

 Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurudyal Singh states that the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 4 months and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
