ANIL KSHETARPAL, J. (ORAL):

Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 313 dated 06.12.2018 under Section 382 IPC, Sections 25/27 of Arms Act (Sections 307/397/120-B IPC and Sections 54/59 of the Arms Act added later on) registered at Police Station City Khanna, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel has pointed out that two co-accused namely Rahul and Pardeep have already been released on regular bail. He further submits that role attributed to the petitioner is similar to that of Rahul and Pardeep Singh. He submits that the petitioner is in custody since 05.01.2019.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Joginder Singh does not dispute the aforesaid position as contended by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and for the reasons recorded in CRM-M-28563-2019, titled "Rahul Vs. State of Punjab" vide order dated 15.07.2019, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
